- **Y1 Phonics** – 87%
- **KS1 SATs (Optional)**
  - Reading 81% Expected 30% Greater Depth
  - Writing 80% Expected 25% Greater Depth
  - Maths 82% Expected 30% Greater Depth
- **Y4 Multiplication Tables Check** – 90% (20+) 70% (24+)
- **KS2 SATs**
  - Reading 90% Expected 38% Greater Depth
  - Writing 85% Expected 28% Greater Depth
  - Maths 87% Expected 30% Greater Depth
  - Combined Reading/Writing/Maths 80% Expected
- **Pupil Premium** – progress and attainment to be in line with peers
- **SEND** – progress and attainment to be in line with national average
- **Sports Premium** – Year 6 swimming 25m and weight/height ratio in line with national average
- **Attendance** at 95%+ overall and 90%+ for every pupil
