Welcome to Maney Hill Primary School and to your new Reception classes. We have really enjoyed getting to know your children already and look forward to watching them settle into their new class and school with the help of their teachers and buddies. In Reception we will have plenty of opportunities to explore, play and learn about the world through lots of different topics.

## Curriculum

In Reception we base our work around topics, each one we focus on for couple of weeks. Our first topic is called '**Marvellous Me**'. The children will be sharing with us what they already know about themselves and their families and about the other children in their class. We will discover things about what makes us unique, our family and local community, our feelings and how to stay healthy and safe. We will continue learning more about ourselves and our local community when looking at our next topic '**People Who Help Us**'. Our final topic this half term will be '**Magic and Potions**'.

During, the second half of this term we will learn about Diwali and Bonfire Night during our '**Light up the sky**' topic. We will also be exploring the topics of '**Autumn**' and '**Celebrations**'.

Throughout the year we will be teaching your child to read using our Read, Write, Inc. Phonics scheme. We will send home all the new sounds we learn each week.
